

Project Case Study



NewPave Asphalt Facility– 2015

Assurance Trees was contracted by New Pave to conduct land clearing of 30 trees in the Tomago industrial estate to make way for a state of the art asphalt manufacturing plant. The project went for 4 days with a crew of 5 arborists and tree workers. We took over 70 tonnes of logs and 50 tonnes of mulch to be recycled as part of the project. This project involved the following aspects:



- Submission of pre-works WHSQ&E documentation
- Site specific familiarisation induction
- Felling and chipping of over 30 trees onsite, some more than 1.5 metres in diameter at the truck. Transporting of all waste off site to be recycled at local landscaping facility. Logs taken off site to be recycled into firewood.
- The work was completed by a team of 5 arborists in 4 days.
- All waste was taken off site in accordance with New Pave DA conditions and environmental procedures.
- Total value of the project was approximately \$32,000.00
